A contractor has now been appointed by Fife Council and work will start shortly. The Phase 1 works include:

- Remove roof tiles and lay aside for re-use.
- Dismantle and skip complete bus shelter.
- Lift existing slab and skip.
- Excavate and form new slab.
- Erect steelwork, roof trusses, sarking, facia, felt, roof tiles, cast iron gutters and downpipes, timber seat, frames with toughened glass, frames with larch lining, two frames covered with Perspex, fit double sided display and bus timetable sign (supplied by client), fit timber seat, build two stone walls, paint and varnish all areas as required with the exception of trusses and sarking which come pre-treated.

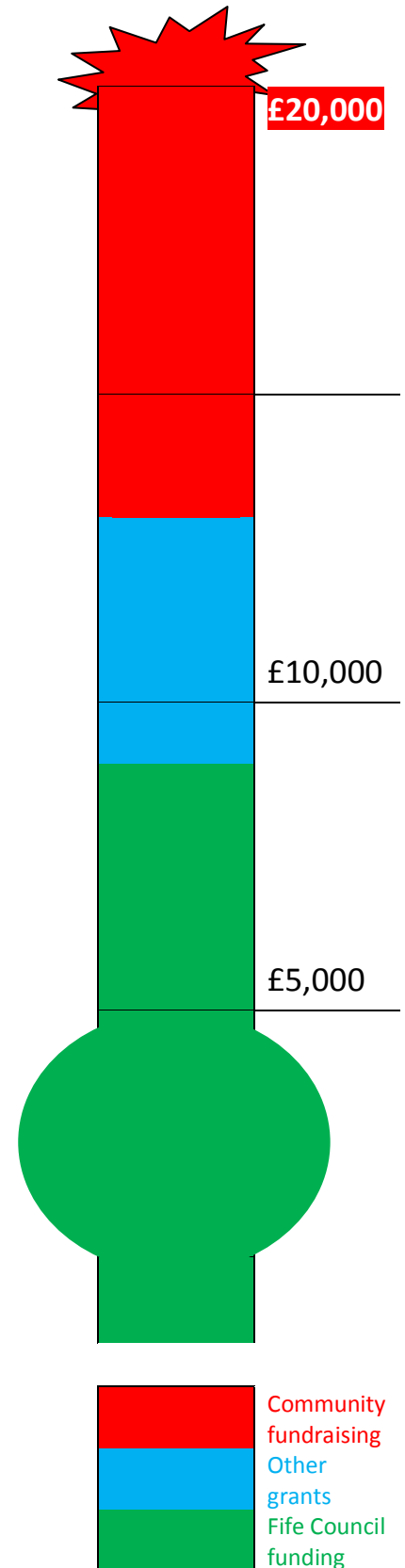
